

## How to find your ring size:

Please print this page and ensure that the paper size is accurate with with a ruler bellow.

Tip: In your printer dialog box 'Paper Size' should be set to A4 and 'Scale' to 100%.

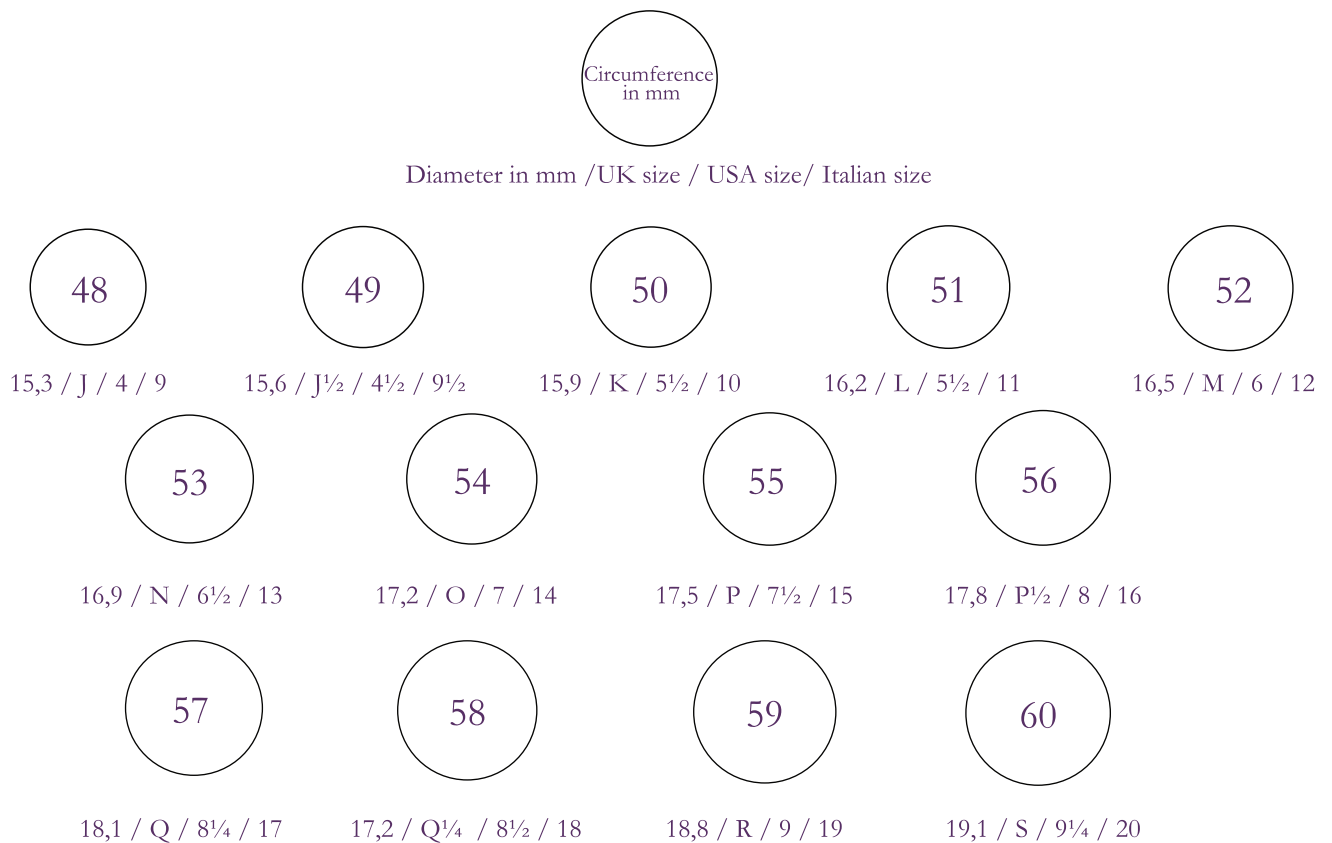


### Method One

Choose one ring that fits comfortably on the appropriate finger; preferably a band, so you can measure it with ease. Then, using the diagram bellow, find the appropriate circle to match the INSIDE circumference of the ring, which is the Kultia ordering size (Make sure the inside edge of the ring is fitting against the matching circle). This way you will find your circumference number and will be able to translate it to the most popular international sizes. In the case you feel that your ring falls between two sizes, it is advisable to choose the larger size.

### Method Two

With a ruler, measure the INSIDE diameter of your chosen ring. Use the diagram bellow to find your size. In the case you feel that your ring falls between two sizes it is advisable to choose the larger size.



### Finger Sizing Tips

- Please note that finger size could change throughout the day; as we become tired or depending on the temperature. Fingers are larger towards the end of the day and when warm. Thus is better to avoid measuring our size with cold fingers as it might be up to ½ size down.
- Keep also in mind that a ring with a wide band will feel tighter than that with a thinner band. In this case, it is better, to select one size up than the one you usually wear.
- We recommend that the ring should fit your finger comfortably and be loose enough to slide in over your knuckle.
